The Umpire hereby releases, discharges and covenants not to sue the WCUA or its officers, agents, and employees (herein referred to as "Releases") from any and all claims and Liability arising out of strict liability or ordinary negligence of Releases which causes the Umpire injury, death, damages or property damages in any way connected with the training or services provided by the Association under this agreement. The Umpire hereby assumes full responsibility for any risk of bodily injury, death, or property damage due to the strict liability or negligence of the releases while participating in such training and services, including travel to and from such meetings.

Umpire understands that he/she must sign-in at their assigned field in order to be paid for their game(s).

The Umpire understands that he/she must give at least 48-hour notification to the WCUA of any games that he/she cannot do. Failure to do so is an automatic fine equal to the game fee for the first offense and \$15.00 + an amount equal to the game fee for the second and subsequent offenses. The Umpire also understands that he/she is required to be at the game site a minimum of 15 (fifteen) minutes prior to the scheduled start time of the game. Failure to do so can result in the loss of the game and the game fee, and WILL result in a fine according to the first/second offense basis.

Umpire understands that as an independent contractor you are not eligible to collect unemployment insurance from the state due to your affiliation with the WCUA.

As an independent contractor, Umpire is responsible for reporting earnings to the state and federal government. The WCUA will provide a 1099 form if earnings exceed \$600.00.

The Umpire understands that the WCUA has NO workers compensation insurance. THEREFORE, UMPIRE Is NOT ELIGIBLE TO COLLECT WORKERS COMPENSATION from the state due to injury suffered at an assignment taken from the WCUA. In addition, the Umpire Accepts Full and Sole Responsibility for arranging any health or accident insurance coverage while on an assignment for the WCUA. The WCUA accepts NO responsibility for injury to Umpire while on an assignment for the WCUA.
